

Information required for filing Australian design applications

Essential information

- A least one set of drawings from which copies may be made
- The name of the product for which registration is required
- The full name of each designer
- The name and address of each applicant
- If Convention priority is claimed, the country, application date and application number for each priority application
- To allow us to complete a statement of newness and distinctiveness, the identity of any particular novel features of the design

Please note:

- A certified copy of each priority application is required if examination is requested
- Although multiple designs may be included in a single application we recommend the filing of multiple applications since there is no saving in fees and each design is registered and renewed separately
- A request for examination must be filed and a design certified before it may be enforced
- Designs are registered and published typically within about 2-6 months
- There is no mechanism to prevent publication
- No Power of Attorney or Authorisation of Agent is required
- No forms are required to be signed by an applicant
